Fin De Fiesta Flamenco presents Mala Yerba Nunca Muere at the Acton Town Hall Centre for one night only on Thursday, April 3, at 8 p.m.

Fin De Fiesta Flamenco is made up of guitarist and singer Dennis Duffin, singer and dancer Tamar Ilana and dancers Lia Grainger and Alexandra Talbot.

The group is currently touring their latest production, Mala Yerba Nunca Muere ("Wild Flowers Never Die"). The name is taken from an old Spanish idiom that describes the capacity to endure. At the core of this show is an exploration of flamenco's capacity to invoke striking contrasts, from delicate beauty to a fierceness that borders on carnal. From refined to raw. Mala Yerba Nunca Muere incorporates the traditional and the contemporary to create an electrifying portrait of an art form that shatters traditional stereotypes of beauty.


