## Making a point

Constantine Karolidis is a Hearing Instrument Specialist with 20 years of experience and owner of Halton Audiometric Centre clinic at Unit 44, 360 Guelph St., Georgetown. More than half of Canadians over the age of 65 will experience some degree of hearing loss; yet, the average person has trouble hearing for 7 to 10 years before having their hearing examined by a hearing healthcare professional. Studies have shown that people with a mild hearing loss are twice as likely to develop dementia and that hearing loss can lead to social isolation and depression. Untreated, hearing loss has been linked to reduced alertness and increased risk to personal safety. See story page 5.
