on the Sunshine List, up from 29 in 2012.

There was actually a three-way tie for the top of the list amongst Halton Hills staffers as Edward DeSousa, director of corporate services and town treasurer, made \$152,484 in

2013, the same as Chris Mills, director of infrastructure services, and director of recreation and parks, Terry Alvman.

Between the salary and benefits as Mayor of Halton Hills (\$72,770) and his compensation from Halton Region (\$53,123), Rick Bonnette cleared the \$100,000 mark at \$125,893, but didn't actually make the Sunshine List for 2013.

For the Halton District School Board, director David Euale was the RICK BONNETTE highest paid employee at \$227,880, while his counterpart at the Halton Catholic board, Michael Pautler, pulled in \$202, 224.38.

Meanwhile, Halton Region had nearly 500 people named on the 2013 Province of Ontario Sunshine list.

The list featured such returning figures as Commissioner and Medical Officer of Health Dr. Robert Nosal, who received \$302,162.87 in salary and taxable benefits in 2013.

Assistant Medical Officer of Health and Director of Chronic Disease and Oral Health Dr. Monir Taha took home \$263,670.59, while Halton's Chief Administrative Officer Jane Mac-Caskill earned \$264,815.76 while Halton Region Chair Gary Carr's pay clocked in

at \$170,121.80.

Law enforcement didn't come cheaply in 2013 with Halton Police Chief Stephen Tanner taking home \$286,779.91.

Halton Healthcare Services (HHS), which oversees Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital, as well as those in Milton and Georgetown, had 111 people on the Sunshine List, including president and CEO John Oliver, who received \$477,689.76.

HHS Chief of Staff Lorne Martin earned \$427,992.59 while Executive Director Denise Hardenne received \$310,291.52.

Georgetown Hospital CEO and program leader Cindy McDonell checked in at \$146,425,74.
