Learn how to grow a giant pumpkin

The Erin Giant Pumpkin Growers will be hosting a free beginners seminar, How To Grow a Giant Pumpkin, on Wednesday, April 16 beginning at 7 p.m. in the Masonic Hall, 190 Main St. in Erin (beside the fair building).

If you have about 400 square feet and some good seeds the growers will teach you the basics to grow a pumpkin up to 1,000 pounds and maybe even more.

Find out some of the newest growing techniques from a couple of experienced growers from the area. Seeds from some of the Worlds top genetics will be available at the seminar.

There will be a 45-60 minute how-to presentation followed by a Q+A session plus tips for growing some of the other giant vegetables (like giant tomatoes, carrot, beets, rutabaga, cabbage, and others) that you can compete with at the Erin Fall Fair. The first prize winner at the fair last year won \$1,500 for a 1,318-pound pumpkin and the first-prize winner for the Other Giant Vegetable class won \$500 for a 55-pound rutabaga!

Learn what it takes to grow these monsters and compete with some of Ontario's top growers.
