Sullivan learned on Friday through social media that Marrows, who he has known since Grade 8, was missing.

“I’m still hopeful for a miracle, so are his parents,” said Sullivan.

But he added he’s “starting to realize it would be a miracle if they find him alive.”

“At this point you just want to find them, you just want closure,” he said.

He wanted to go up to the park to help search for the men, but said he was told that police aren’t allowing it.

Sullivan describes Marrow as independent, fun loving and funny, “someone that “can make you laugh in any situation.”

“He’s a loving boyfriend, amazing son and one of best friends you can possibly have,” said Sullivan.

Halton Region hosting rain barrel truckload sales

Residents are being encouraged to be efficient with outdoor water use by using Halton Region rain barrels.

On Saturday, May 24, Halton Region will hold the first of four rain barrel truckload sales events as part of Halton’s water efficiency program.

Halton residents can purchase a rain barrel for \$39.95, cash only, at any of the four events (proof of Halton residency required). New this year, residents now have the option to pre-pay online before each rain barrel sales event and can also arrange for home delivery (at an additional cost), directly through the rain barrel supplier.

“The promotion of water conservation

and efficiency continues to be a top priority for Halton Region,” said Regional Chair Gary Carr.

Sales events will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the following locations:

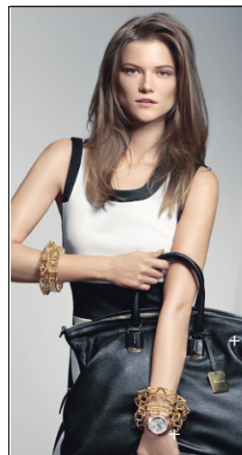
