The Inflatable Child Seat Concept faces the rear of the car, as it is the safest way for children to travel.

A child's neck is under development and not as strong as an adult's neck. In a frontal impact collision, the head of a forward-facing car occupant is thrown forward inducing great stain on the neck.

Children therefore need special restraints and to face the rear of the vehicle until at least 3-4 years of age.


