

Saturday last day to drop off brush at Acton Works Yard

Saturday (May 31) will be the last day residents can drop off brush to the Acton Works Yard at 1 Commerce Court.

Area residents will still be able to dispose of brush at the R.C. Austin Operations Centre, 1620 Trafalgar Rd., Georgetown, which will re-

main open until Town staff determines that clean-up efforts have reached a level where demand for dumping has been dramatically reduced or eliminated.

The Town and Halton Region will continue to clean up brush from the roadside,

park, trails and ravine lots within Halton Hills.

"We are overwhelmed by the response of the residents of Acton who have pitched in to help clean up the Town," said Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette.

"The amount of storm de-

bris and brush that has accumulated in the Acton yard is a testament to the pride that property owners take in the appearance and housekeeping of their homes."

The closing of the Acton disposal site will allow Town of Halton Hills contracted

staff the ability to grind up and dispose of the materials already left on site.

In addition, Halton Region will hold Special Waste Drop-off Days throughout the year and on Saturday, June 21 the Acton yard will be the site of this event.

PLEASE NOTE

1. If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Official Plan amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills – PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT & SUSTAINABILITY DEPARTMENT at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.
2. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Halton Hills to the Ontario Municipal Board.
3. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
4. Any written comment/objection submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding the amendment which is being processed under the *Planning Act*, may be made public as part of the application process.

In 2011, building on the Town's existing Green Development Evaluation Checklist which had been in place since 2010, Council approved undertaking the Green Development Standards Study. Approved by Council on April 28, 2014, the Green Development Standards put in place a practical, highly flexible and comprehensive 'second generation' set of criteria that are anticipated to materialize in more sustainable, high-performance and efficient development. Through a practical set of Green Development Standards, development's many positive attributes can be maximized while its potentially negative impacts can be minimized.

The Green Development Standards Study and the related draft Official Plan amendment have been developed through a multi-phase public process.
