Bike Challenge reaches halfway goal

Participants in the Halton Hills Community Cycling Challenge have reached the halfway point of 150,000 kms logged.

The Challenge was launched on April 28 and so far has attracted over 650 participants of all ages and abilities. These cyclists have faithfully logged every kilometre they have ridden onto a dedicated website www.bikechallenge.ca.

At the halfway point, Bike Challenge sponsors are making good on their pledges to the Georgetown Hospital Foundation. Georgetown Canadian Tire presented a cheque for \$20,000 to Georgetown Hospital Foundation as did Superior Glove for \$2,000; Ollie's Cycle and Skim \$1000;

Young Dentistry, \$1,000; HealthSpan Wellness, \$500 and Betty D'Oliveira, \$500.

"We are thrilled to be receiving \$25,000 from local sponsors of the Bike Challenge. It is terrific to have this support from both sponsors and the cyclists," said Georgetown Hospital Foundation Executive Director K.C. Carruthers.

This is the second year for the Halton Hills Community Cycling Challenge which is a project of the Town's Bicycle Friendly Community Committee. After successfully reaching the 200,000 km goal last year, the Committee set this year's goal at 300,000 kms or 7 1/2 times around the Earth!
