### Is Your Name on the Town's Voters List?

The Town of Halton Hills Preliminary Voters List has been prepared. Residents can check to see if they are on the Voters List by:

- Checking on-line at [www.haltonhills.ca](http://www.haltonhills.ca)
- By visiting the Civic Centre, Corporate Services - Customer Service Desk

A person may make an application to the Town Clerk requesting:

- That their name be added or removed from the Voters Lists or;
- That their information on the Voters List be amended

To amend the Voters List you must file an application with the Town Clerk or her designate. Applications are available at Corporate Services - Customer Service Desk, Town of Halton Hills, 1 Halton Hills Drive, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Changes to the list can also be made at any four Advance Voting Locations being held on Wednesday, October 15, Saturday, October 18 and Wednesday, October 22, 2014; and also on Election Day October 27, 2014.

Please note that electronic or facsimile copies of the application form will not be accepted.

### Candidate Deadline 2014 Municipal Election Deadline For Candidate Registration/nomination

The deadline for filing nomination papers to be a Candidate in the upcoming Municipal Election is 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 12, 2014.

Candidates may file a nomination form with the Town Clerk during the Civic Centre's regular business hours - Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

A prescribed fee, in the amount of \$200.00 for Mayoral candidates and \$100.00 for all other candidates payable by cash, certified cheque, money order, or by debit, must accompany the nomination form.

**Please Note:** A person who proposes to be a candidate may not solicit or accept contributions for election purposes, or incur expenses, until after that person has filed nomination papers with the Town Clerk.

The nomination form is available from the office of the Town Clerk.

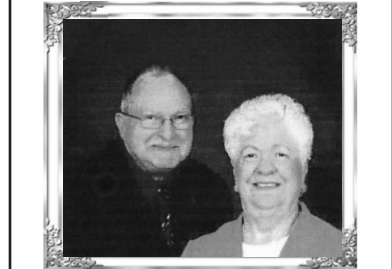
