January 26, 1929 - September 16, 2014

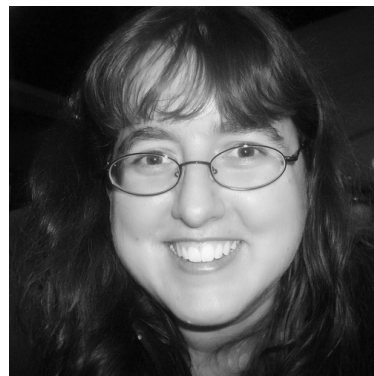

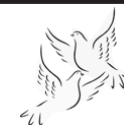
