

NHKR holds microchip, rabies clinic

Gerda Potzel, a volunteer with the North Halton Kitten Rescue, has an armload of supplies for the rabies and microchip clinic to be held at The Old Armoury (1A Park Ave.) this Saturday, Oct. 18, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. "Seventy-five microchips are available and she would like to see all of them used at the clinic," said Potzel. A \$30 microchip greatly improves the odds of having your pet returned if they have strayed from home. When a stray is found the first step to finding owners is to have them scanned free at any veterinarian business. The clinic is using three-year rabies vaccines which are an affordable \$20. Cash only. Potzel wants to remind pet owners "It is the law in Ontario to have your dog or cat vaccinated for rabies," and suggests "this an opportunity for people to bring their barn cats and farm dogs." Dogs and cats have separate entrances and registration areas so skittish pets will be more relaxed. While at the clinic have your pet's nails trimmed for \$10.
