#### **Dancers raise 10Gs for CAShh**

The fourth-annual Dancers for Cancer fundraiser at Christ the King Secondary School held back in April turned out to be the biggest so far as more than 400 students from around the GTA and beyond came together to generate \$10,000 for Cancer Assistance Services Halton Hills.
