Raspberry Swirl

Cookies

Makes 5 dozen

Ingredients

- 3 and 1/4 cups flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 tsp almond flavouring (optional – can use vanilla)
- 2 cups coconut (optional)



- raspberry (or any red) jam
- Method**
1. Mix flour, soda and salt. Set aside.
 2. Cream shortening, butter and sugars until creamy. Add eggs one at a time.
 3. Add water and flavouring to butter mixture. Blend in flour mixture and coconut.
 4. Drop by the tablespoonful onto greased cookie sheet. Make a little dent in the dough with your finger. Put one quarter tsp of jam in the depression, daub a little batter on top.
 5. Bake at 400 degrees F. for 10 minutes.


