Prescription drop-off is now all day, any day

Halton Regional Police is trying to do its part to combat an increase in the abuse of prescription drugs.

The service has installed a prescription drug drop box in the front lobby of its five police stations to accommodate the safe and anonymous disposal of unused and unwanted prescription medicines at any time.

For the past two years, Halton police has participated in the National Prescription Drug Drop-Off Day (PDOD), seizing more than 65 kilograms (143 lbs.) of unused and unwanted prescription drugs.

As the PDOD only occurs once a year, Halton police says members of the public stockpile medications in anticipation of disposal

day. In addition, local pharmacies often collect and hold on to returned narcotics until the PDOD, leaving them prone to internal theft or a robbery, say police.

So police have gone to employing an all-day, any day dropoff program.

"Medication of any type can be harmful for children and adults alike, especially when in the wrong hands and used for the wrong reasons. In Ontario, 72 per cent of youths who used prescriptions drugs unlawfully obtained them from their household," say police.

The public can drop off unused prescription medication at: the Georgetown station, 217 Guelph St. and the Milton station, 490 Childs Dr.
