

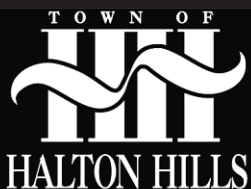

Halton Hills firefighters responded to a report of a fuel leak about 11 a.m. Tuesday (Nov. 25) on Armstrong Ave. On scene, crews found a tractor-trailer on the side of the road with diesel fuel leak-

ing from the driver's-side fuel tank. Upon closer inspection it was determined the fuel was leaking from the drain plug threads. Firefighters put down absorbent on the road and filled jugs with the leak-

ing fuel. The storm sewer that was approximately 40 yards away was covered with a rubber mat to prevent spillage. Firefighters remained on scene until the spill response team arrived.
