

# GLT opens Lewis Black comedy, *One Slight Hitch*, next week

Georgetown Little Theatre's next hilarious offering in their laugh local season is again dedicated to the exploration of marriage and relationships. But this

one, by eminently funny comedian Lewis Black, certainly has a twist.

Directed by Steve Prevost and produced by Virginia Bancur, *One Slight Hitch* is set in upper-middle class suburban Cincinnati circa 1981. It opens with teenager PB Coleman (Alexa Leal)

introducing her very dysfunctional family, including parents, Doc and Delia, middle sister Melanie (Carly Bravo) and her eldest sister, Courtney (Esther Chung) who is to be wed that very afternoon to the wonderfully solid Harper Whittington (Ryk Simpson).

Delia (Ro Palumbo-Coates) is stressed, completing preparations for a lavish wedding that she herself never had. Everything must be absolutely perfect, the dress, the groom and especially the decorations— if they ever arrive! Then, the doorbell rings and Doc (Paul d'Entremont) opens the door to a very unexpected guest, Courtney's affable ex-boyfriend, Ryan (Kristoffer Brown), who is totally unaware of the engagement and, by all accounts, is the polar opposite of Courtney's soon-to-be husband.

COMMON QUESTIONS  
ABOUT TINNITUS - PART 2  
DO WE KNOW WHAT  
TINNITUS IS??

The actual cause or event or mechanism of Tinnitus is not known. We know it is real; it is a symptom that something is wrong in the auditory system, but we do not know what that something is. We do know that it is not the patient's imagination; it is a physiological or neurological event. There is reason to be hopeful because current research using a Tinnitus model may provide the necessary information for identifying its cause.

**IS IT ASSOCIATED WITH HEARING LOSS?**  
In most cases, Tinnitus is associated with some hearing loss. For example, those who have been exposed to excessively loud sounds may have a hearing loss for the high pitched tones. Usually their Tinnitus will be located as a high pitched tone in the region of the hearing loss. In some cases Tinnitus is present where there is no hearing loss and for no discernable reason.
