Benefit concert, bench to honour fallen friends

A benefit concert to celebrate the lives of three local natives who died in a fire in Toronto last year will take place Saturday night at the McGibbon Hotel and a memorial park bench in their names was unveiled this week in downtown Georgetown.

In the early morning hours of March 7, 2014, Katie Charron, 21, Alysia Graham, 22, and Jordan Boyer, 22, were killed in an apartment blaze in the in the Dovercourt Rd. and Dupont St. area in Toronto that was home to four close friends who went to school together in Georgetown.

Ethan Leal, then 21, suffered minor inju-

ries in the fire.

Investigators found that there were no working smoke detectors on the second floor, where the victims were found.
