

The Directors of the Georgetown Bread Basket want to send out a Big Thank-You to the community for their overwhelming generous response to support the food bank over this past year.




Local support from individuals, churches, schools, major area corporations, local businesses, community groups, clubs and associations were key to our ability to provide food to those in need in our community over the past year.
