Experience food from around the world at our Multicultural Potluck Lunch on Tuesday, June 9, at noon. Sign up at Reception and with what dish you are bringing.

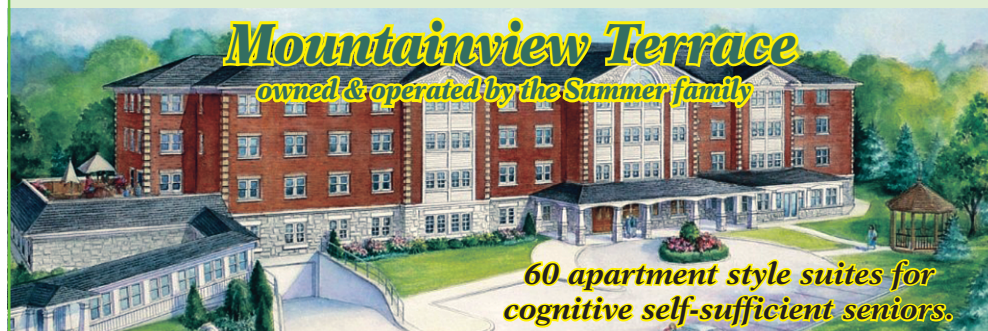
