Giant Hogweed has been found in the Town of Halton Hills. This is a giant plant that looks like "Queen Anne's Lace" but is Very Dangerous to handle. If you find it, please do not touch it with your bare hands and keep children away (April/May) to eliminate spread For further information on Giant Hogweed


please visit www.ontarioinvasiveplants.ca. Community Standards By-law 2008-0138 No. Part 3, Section 8 states "Property Owners are

required to destroy and remove all nuisance weeds and weed seeds on their land. For a list of nuisance weeds please refer to www.haltonhills.ca/bylaws. Any person who

fails to destroy and remove all nuisance weeds and weed seeds is guilty of an offence. As a result, the Town of Halton Hills may enter upon your property to do the work required.

The Town may recover the costs of doing any work or matter by action and adding the costs to the tax roll and collecting it in a like manner as property tax.

Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are NOT considered nuisance

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with The Weed Control Act R.S.O. 1990, c. W.5., that unless weed seeds and noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Town of

Woolly Cupgrass Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are NOT considered noxious weeds under The Weed Control Act.
