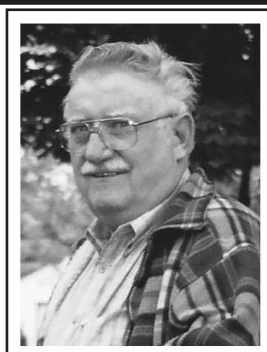


**YOUMANS, Elizabeth Irene "Betty"**
