Recipients of this award may or may not receive special education services.

Students were recognized for demonstrating outstanding qualities in more than one of the following areas: academic, vocational, athletic, self-improvement, community work, citizenship and student leadership. Each elementary and secondary public school within the Halton District School Board nominates one of their students for this recognition.

"These recipients represent the high degree of student achievement in academics, athletics, school and community services, and leadership," said David Euale, Director of Education for the Halton District School Board. "We have the future of Halton in our schools today."
