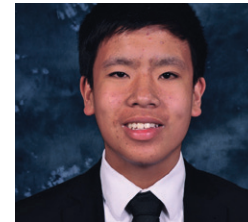
Cameron Zanolla - St. Brigid

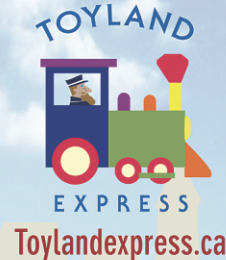
