Registration open for water festival

Registration for the 10th annual Halton Children's Water Festival is now open. The festival runs from Sept. 29 to Oct. 2 at the Kelso Conservation Area in Milton and is open to students in grades 2 to 5.

Halton-area teachers can register their classes online at www.hcwf.ca until Sept. 18, 2015. Teachers are encouraged to register early as there are limited spots per grade.

The Halton Children's Water Festival was first held in 2006 and was launched with the assistance of a grant from the Ontario Trillium

Foundation. Over the years, the festival has expanded with more students participating over more days. The 2015 festival will feature a variety of activities designed to educate children about water— one of the world's most precious natural resources— in a fun, outdoor environment.
