

General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss the proposed applications to amend the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan and Zoning By-law 2010-0050, as amended.

The proposed amendment applications apply to the lands legally described as Part of Lot 20, Concession 8, Former Esquesing Township, Town of Halton Hills, Regional Municipality of Halton. The subject lands are municipally known as 8 & 10 Lindsay Court and 13758 & 13764 Highway 7 (Georgetown), Town of Halton

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed amendments would apply.



The purpose and effect of the amendment applications are to permit up to 141 condominium townhouse units on a common element condominium on the subject lands.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law amendment applications, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills - PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT & SUSTAINABILITY Office at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario

NOTES:

- 1. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan and/or Zoning By-law amendments are adopted/passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Halton Hills to the Ontario Municipal
- 2. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan and/or Zoning By-law amendments are adopted/passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
- 3. Any written comment/objection submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this application(s) which is being processed under the Planning Act 1990, may be made public as part of the application process.
