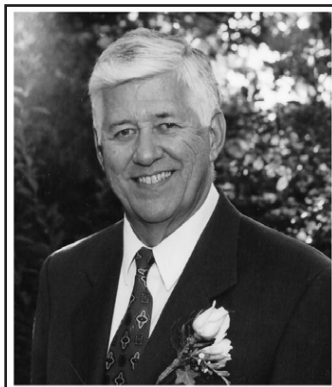

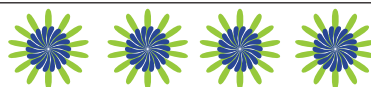


BELLAMY, John R.
