

With the hot, hazy days of summer approaching, the Halton Children's Aid Society has some valuable tips for parents, caregivers and the general public about car safety.

The facts are simple.

- The temperature inside a parked car can exceed 50 C within 10 to 20 minutes on a typical Canadian summer day;
- Opening the window(s) slightly does not reduce the temperature;

- Heatstroke occurs at 40.50C;
- Young children, especially infants, are three to five times more sensitive to heat than adults:
- Rising temperatures inside a car can cause a child to suffer from heat stress, dehydration, shock and, in extreme cases, even death.
