Expect some traffic tie-ups on Friday

Motorists in Halton Hills can expect some traffic tie-ups Friday, possibly around the noon hour, as a pre-fabricated bridge will be transported to Cedarvale Park, where it will replace an old bridge near the community centre.

Norval-based S&S Transport has been tasked with moving the 25-footwide bridge from its manufacturer in Barrie Friday morning.

Headed up by a Halton Regional Police escort, the bridge will travel along Hwy. 407 to Oakville and then head north up Trafalgar Rd. into Georgetown.

From there, the bridge will travel eastward along Maple Ave. to the Main St. intersection at Cedarvale Park.
