Town welcomes new pediatrician with incentive cheque, loan

There's a new doctor in town.

Dr. Muhaned Marah has joined the pediatric clinic at the Georgetown Hospital, with financial support through the Physician Recruitment Program, which was initiated in 2009 to recruit doctors to the community.

The program provides a \$5,000 grant and a \$10,000 interest-free loan repayable over five years. The funds can be used for the purchase of equipment or to set up an office and Dr. Marah has agreed to maintain an active practice for a minimum of five years.

"Halton Hills is a great place to live and work and having local medical care is very important to maintain our high quality of life," said Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette.


