Mold-Masters SportsPlex gets Silver LEED certification

Mold-Masters SportsPlex has been awarded LEED Silver certification as a result of its twinning project in 2013. LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification is presented to qualifying buildings by the Canada Green Building Council to encourage and facilitate the development of more sustainable buildings.

"We are very excited to achieve this recognition for the Mold-Masters SportsPlex Arena Expansion Project," said Stephen Hamilton, the Manager of Recreation Facilities. "The facility is not only a wonderful recreation facility for the community, but also boasts exceptional energy efficiency and innovation in its design. The design team had worked very hard on delivering a facility that is both functional for its purpose and supports sustainable practices."

The new addition is fully accessible, energy efficient and incorporated equipment that optimizes the energy performance of the building and enhances the refrigeration management. The design has maximized the use of natural light, incorporated numerous sustainable materials and processes in its construction, enhances water efficiency and has employed re-used heat throughout the facility. In partnership with Halton Hills Hydro the facility is also home to a number of charging stations for electric vehicles. The roof of the facility has been fitted with 1,767 solar panels, which will be used to generate renewable energy for the community.
