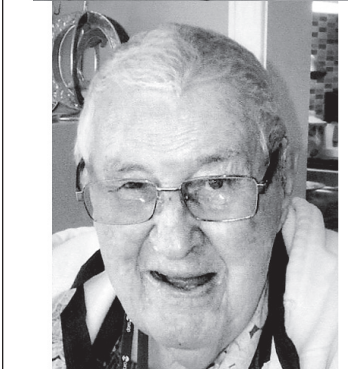
James L. Jones
