Please place your waste at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled holiday collection day.

### Garbage tag exemption

Areas 3, 4 and 5: Your first garbage collection day after Christmas Day (December 25) will **not** require garbage tags; however, the **six garbage bag/can limit applies**.
