Two tellers assaulted during armed robbery of Acton bank

Halton Police continue to search for a suspect who they say assaulted two bank tellers during an armed robbery of a Bank of Montreal in Acton.

According to police, on Friday (Dec. 18) at approximately 5 p.m., a lone masked suspect entered the Bank of Montreal branch located at 21 Mill St. E.

Once inside the suspect brandished a firearm and demanded money.

A quantity of cash was turned over to a male suspect, who then

fled the scene on foot in an unknown direction.

During the course of the incident, police say two bank tellers were assaulted by the suspect, sustaining minor injuries.

The suspect is described as male, black, in his early 20s, approximately 5-foot-6 to 5-foot-8 tall, with a thin build and wearing a black balaclava, grey hoodie sweater, black pants and grey high top shoes.
