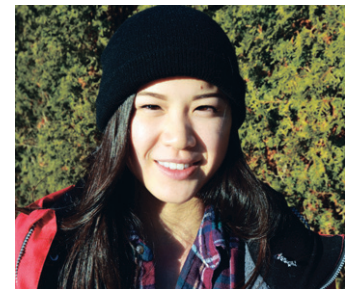

Head-on crash on Guelph St. sends two to hospital

Guelph St. was closed between Georgetown and Norval for much of the afternoon Tuesday following a head-on crash between two vehicles at about 1 p.m.

Halton Regional Police Sgt. Colin Grierson said the two lone oc-

cupants of each vehicle—a Hyundai Santa Fe SUV and a Chevrolet Silverado pickup—were rushed to hospital.

As of Wednesday morning, the driver of the Santa Fe was reported to be still in hospital with non-life-threatening injuries, while the pickup truck driver remained in Georgetown Hospital in serious

but stable condition.

Both drivers had to be extricated from their vehicles by the Halton Hills Fire Department. Preliminary investigation indicated that one of the vehicles crossed the centre median.

Debris from the vehicles was strewn all over the four-lane roadway.

It was not snowing at the time of the collision, although bitterly cold temperatures and strong winds swept through the area.

The HRPS collision reconstruction unit was on scene for several hours investigating the incident.

Early reports from the crash scene indicate that an off-duty nurse attended to the victims.
