Sheldon noted that help for these new families extends beyond clothing and furniture; it's also about assisting them in accessing local services such

as doctors, mental health programs, schools, ESL services, and more.

"You really have to plan for everything," she said. "When you get involved in something like this and put together a profile of the community and all of the available services, you see the whole picture and realize how lucky we are. We are really fortunate to live here."

Galligan said the church is also taking into account the refugees' cultural differences in its community re-

source information, such as determining where to buy Halal foods, which female doctors are accepting patients for Muslim women who prefer to see a female, etc.

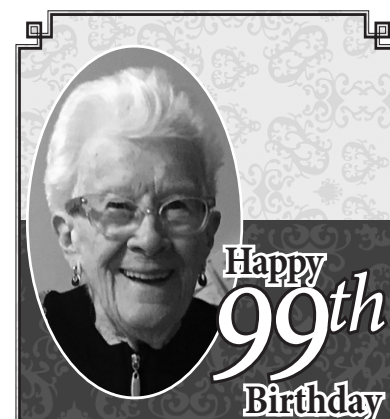

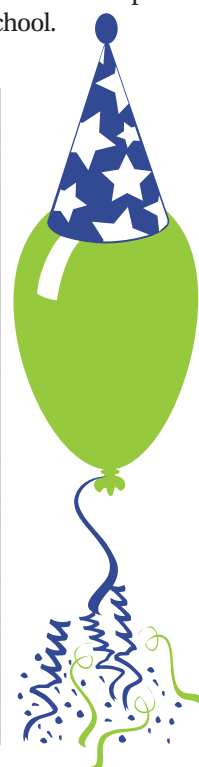
HCDSB to hold Kindergarten registration next week
