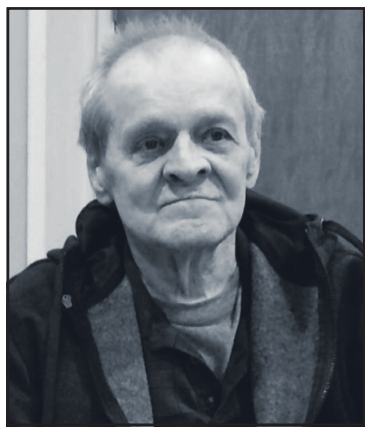
**BRIGDEN, Allen Paul**
