

MPP Ted Arnott calls on MTO to partner on Acton bypass study

Member of **Provincial** Parliament asks province to be funding partner on Phase 2 of study

Wellington-Halton Hills MPP Ted Arnott is calling on the minister of transportation to take action on developing a Highway 7 bypass around Acton.

Arnott put forward a motion in December asking for provincial support in commissioning a study on the project, which passed unanimously.

After a cabinet shuffle late last year, Arnott's goal is to invite the new Minister of Transportation Kathryn McGarry to the town of Halton Hills for a meeting about the highway bypass.

Arnott says that when the house sits next week, he hopes to raise the question again, noting that he is willing to reach across party lines and work with the

Liberal cabinet minister to get the study off the ground.

This comes after the province voted to ditch the contentious GTA West Highway project.

Arnott says he agrees **Dufferin-Caledon** MPP Sylvia Jones in her sharp criticism of the Liberal government's spending on years of studies.

"I would agree with her that it would appear that \$14 million has been wasted," he said, in speaking about the documents Jones received from a Freedom of Information request about the costs of studies on the proposed highway. "It's quite amazing that after all those years of studies that they decided to scrap it."

Arnott's focus going forward will be to lobby for the province of Ontario to act as a funding partner for Phase 2 of the Acton Bypass study. The town of Halton Hills is currently working on the first phase of the process.
