

You too can be a master of pot

trate is refined from pot flowers into a more potent form. A concentrate is hash (pressed hash or water hash), hash oil, kief, shatter or budder. Concentrates are powerful and preferred by medical and recreational smokers.

TRICHOMES: Trichomes are the resin glands of the marijuana plant that resemble hairs that contain THC, CBD (keep reading) and other medicinal cannabinoids. Trichomes are what make the pot plant so groovy.

COTTONMOUTH/DRY MOUTH: Cottonmouth or dry-mouth is a side effect of smoking some marijuana strains. The mouth becomes dry and often pot smokers chew gum or suck on candies.

DABS: A dab is a small piece of concentrate, like wax, hash oil, or shatter. It's smoked by "dabbing" or placing on a heat source or flame to produce vapour, which is inhaled.

DABBING: Dabbing is the latest method used to consume powerful weed concentrates. Dabbing is popular due to its potency. (See above.)

DIESEL: Diesel is a type of pot that has a sativa effect and smells like diesel. Diesel is favoured for its potency, smell and taste.

EDIBLES: Edibles are pot-infused products that are eaten, including cookies, brownies, gummies and more.

FATTY: A fatty is a very thick blunt or joint containing a large amount of marijuana.

GRINDER: A grinder is a round metal, steel or wood device used to shred marijuana to make rolling joints or filling a bowl easier.

HASH: Hash or hashish is the gathering of trichomes using a sieve or water extraction technique. The final substance is pressed and then smoked. It resembles black or brown Playdough.

HYBRID: The best of both worlds, hybrid strains contain a mix of sativa and indica genetics. Hybrid users can experience both the psychoactive marijuana effects and the warm body buzz which comes from CBD.

HYDROPONICS: Hydroponics is a technique to grow marijuana that uses no soil. Water circulates to the plant's roots using a tray system.

INDICA: Indica plants are smaller but produce more bud. Indicas are high in CBD and produce a relaxing body buzz, which is used to treat pain, anxiety and insomnia.

KIEF: Kief is made by separating trichomes from the weed plant. Often called dry sieve hash because screens are used to make the extraction. Kief contains the most cannabinoids, making it very potent.

KUSH: Kush is an indica strain of weed originating from Afghanistan and Pakistan. A kush plant is small in size and offers relaxing or sedating effects.

OUNCE: An ounce is 28 grams of pot, or four quarters of pot. Usually bought as a bulk purchase to save cash. Often called on the street an OZ (oh-zee).

PINNER/PIN: A small joint containing a tiny amount of cannabis.

SATIVA: Sativa is a variety originating along the equator. The sativa plant grows tall, more than five feet. Sativas are high in THC and used for their energetic cerebral effects, often used to treat depression. Be warned, smoking sativa strains can create paranoia.

SHATTER: Shatter is a concentrate that some users say is the most powerful form of marijuana. Shatter is made through an extraction process that removes fats and lipids. It's transparent or pale yellow and users break it into chunks before smoking.

THC: Tetrahydrocannabinol was first discovered in marijuana in 1964, and is known for its psychoactive effects, which makes you feel stoned.
