

Georgetown getting second Baskin-Robbins location

Baskin Robbins is expanding their franchises in the GTA, and in planning on opening a second shop in Georgetown.

The expansion will include three new shops in Toronto, in addition to the Georgetown store, which are expected to open in 2019.
