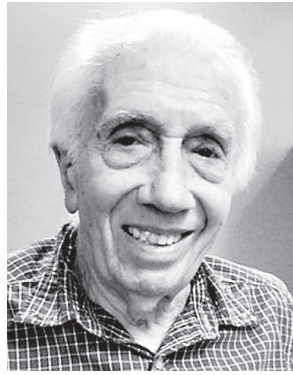

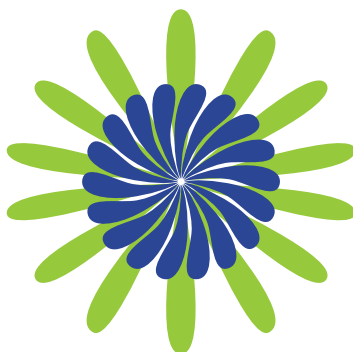
HARVEY, Tillie
