July 13, 1928 - February 27, 2018

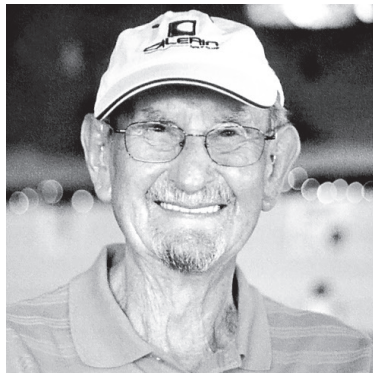

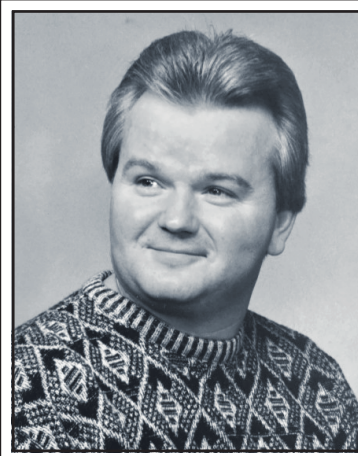


**MARSHALL, Robert**

**STADDON, Norah Mabel**

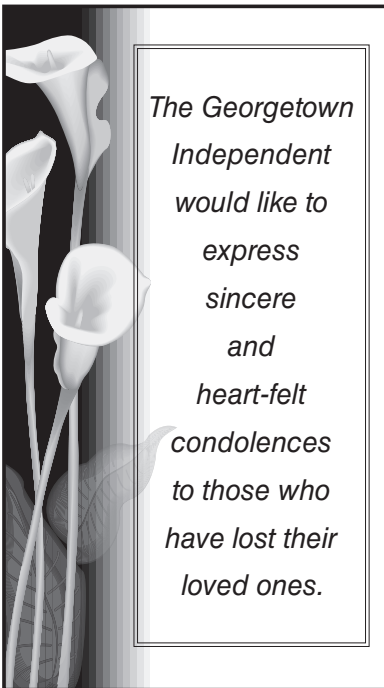

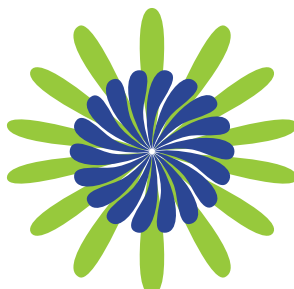
