Three deaths in Halton this year from Group A strep

Halton Region public health is confirming that three people have died since the beginning of this year from Group A strep infections.

The bacteria, which ranges from very mild infections to severe cases, has taken the life of a young mother in Markham earlier this month.

In rare cases, strep A bacteria can lead to an invasive gas disease (iGAS), which is when the bacteria enter the bloodstream.

In Halton, there have been eight reported cases of Group A strep, three of which have been fa-


