Suspects sought in theft of jeans from Georgetown store

Halton police are looking for two suspects after more than \$1,500 worth of jeans were stolen from a Georgetown clothing store on Saturday, March 31.

At around 10:45 a.m., a man and woman entered the Mark's store located in the Georgetown Market Place mall and began selecting Levi's jeans.

Police allege both individuals began concealing the jeans in a backpack the man was carrying.

The suspects then left the store without paying for the clothing.

The stolen property triggered the store's alarm as they left, at which point store staff contacted police.

The male suspect is described as black, in his early 20s, six-foot, 150 pounds with black hair and dark eyes.

He wore an olive coloured hoodie under a black vest, grey jeans, black sneakers

and carried a dark backpack.

The woman is described as white, in her early 20s, five-foot-two, 160 pounds with red hair.

She wore a black T-shirt, white and black patterned yoga pants, brown shoes and

a tan coloured baseball cap. She carried a large white bag.
