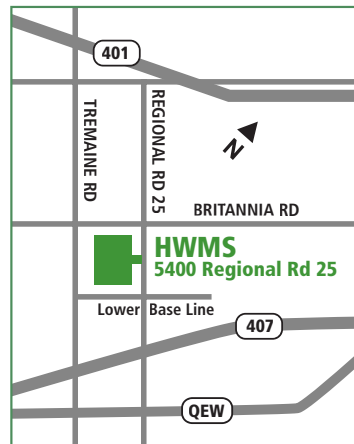




Compost Giveaway

Halton residents are invited to attend this year's Spring Compost Giveaway as a thank-you for helping divert approximately 27,000 tonnes of yard waste last year. During the event, Halton residents can take up to the equivalent of seven garbage bags of compost per household, **free of charge**.

Remember to bring:

- Your own bags or containers (maximum seven garbage bags or equivalent per household) and a shovel in order to bag your own compost; and
- A non-perishable food item or cash donation to be distributed to Halton-area food banks – your donations make a difference!

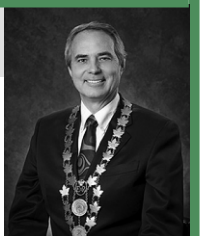

Protect your home from flooding

Our region has already experienced significant rainfall this spring and we want to remind residents of the things they can do to protect their homes from flooding. Residents are encouraged to take advantage of Halton's Basement Flooding Mitigation Subsidy Program that makes it easier and more affordable to make modifications that can reduce the risk of flooding. If you are planning on disconnecting your downspouts or weeping tiles, installing a sump pump, repairing your sewer lateral (pipe) or installing a backwater valve, you may be eligible for our subsidy program.
