# EAT THIS: Georgetown's Mangia Bene - Eating well on the go

Looking for some Italian cuisine but don't have time to spend an hour or two in a restaurant?

A food truck located at 375 Guelph St. between the Esso gas station and Shoeless Joe's restaurant, Mangia Bene will mark its fifth anniversary in Georgetown in September and its owner, Russell Priola, said the key to building a loyal clientele starts with topquality ingredients and fresh-made fare.

"I would say 95 per cent of our business is returning customers," said Priola, a master chef trained in Europe who has worked as a chef at luxury hotels in the U.S. and for the Monte Carlo Inn chain in Canada.

"People know what they're getting at reasonable prices. It's nothing extravagant, but it's high quality and people must be happy with it because they keep coming back."

There are several freshly prepared menu options

including baked specialties such as lasagna, sandwiches, burgers, salads, pasta dishes and traditional entrees like veal scalloppini and pollo marsala, along with their specialty sandwich, an Italian/Cuban creation called the porcubonetta.

Sous-chef Lisa Lafontaine has a garden on-site for spices and herbs and while they shop locally for most items on the menu, the San Marzano tomatoes are imported from Venice.

Popular with tradespeople in the area looking for a hearty and quick meal, Priola said the catering side of Mangia Bene is also doing well, with several local businesses, especially auto dealerships, ordering in for large group meals.

Mangia Bene is open from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. from Monday to Saturday and from noon to 8 p.m. Sunday.
