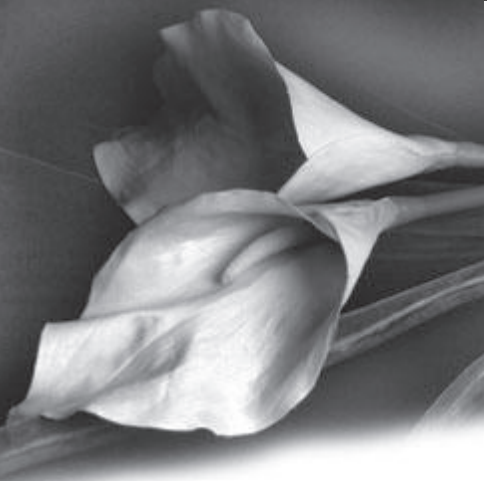
VODDEN, Janice Ann
