2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANDIDATE REGISTRATION/NOMINATION

This notice is for anyone proposing to be a candidate in the Town of Halton Hills Municipal Election on **October 22, 2018 for the offices of:**

- Mayor
- Councillors (Local and Regional)
- Regional Chair (nomination forms to be filed with the Region of Halton)
- Trustee, Halton District School Board
- Trustee, Halton Catholic District School Board
- Trustee, Conseil scolaire Viamonde (nomination forms to be filed with the City of Hamilton)
- Trustee, Conseil scolaire catholique MonAvenir (nomination forms to be filed with the Town of Oakville)

Candidates may file a nomination form during regular business hours as of May 1, 2018 (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.), with the last day for filing being July 27, 2018 (9:00 a.m. until 2 p.m.). Filing of nomination forms to take place at the Clerk's Office - Service Halton Hills Counter.

A prescribed fee which may be refundable, in the amount of \$200.00 for Mayoral candidates and \$100.00 for all other candidates payable by cash, certified cheque, money order, or by debit, must accompany the nomination form as well as 25 signatures endorsing the nomination. (Please Note: 25 signatures of endorsement are not required for School Board Trustees)

A person who proposes to be a candidate may not solicit or accept contributions for election purposes, or incur expenses, until after that person has filed a nomination paper with the Town Clerk.
