Five more entries gained official entry into the Halton Hills Sports Museum's Hall of Fame at the 12th-annual induction ceremony Thursday night at the John Elliott Theatre in Georgetown.

Legendary thoroughbred horse-racing jockey Sandy Hawley was the keynote speaker for the evening.

The Sports Museum and Resource Centre, located in the Gordon Alcott Heritage Hall at the Mold-Masters SportsPlex, welcomed in former Major League Baseball and Team Canada pitcher Shawn Hill; longtime minor pro hockey player and current head coach of the American Hockey League's Utica Comets, Trent Cull; the late

Harry Lawson, another baseball star and builder of the sport in Acton; sports journalist Denis Gibbons, a longtime authority on international hockey; and the remarkable 1987-88 Georgetown Junior Gemini juvenile hockey squad, which won both the Ontario Minor Hockey Association and International Silver Stick championships in the same season.

Hill was unable to attend the event, due to a family commitment in Florida, and was represented by his father, Richard. Lawson's three surviving siblings accepted the award on his behalf.

Save for a couple of team members who've passed away over the years, nearly the entire Junior Gemini "asteroid" was reunited for the 30th anniversary, from as far away as Texas.
