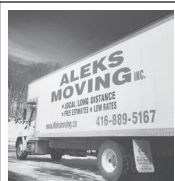

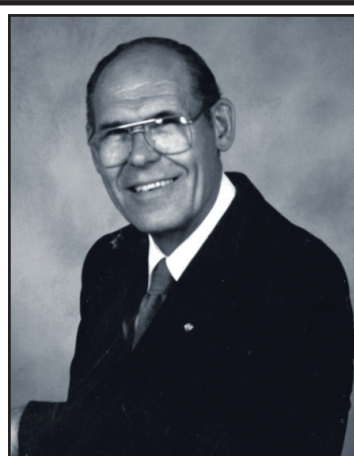


NORMAN, Phyllis Elaine

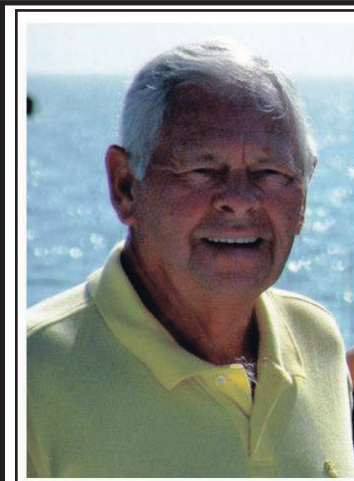

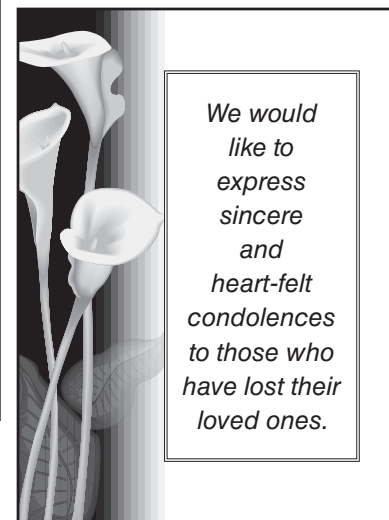
