Judy MacLean uses transit services in Halton Hills almost every day.

Four times a week, the retired financial consultant takes Activan out to the Lion's Club swimming pool in Acton and back to her home in Georgetown.

She buys taxi chits, as well as books of \$3 Activan tickets, which she's been using regularly since undergoing a shoulder operation three years ago.

"I use every imaginable transit service in Halton," she said, explaining that she utilizes Go transit as well.

She says the real issue is crossing out of Halton Hills, like using transit to get to the hospital.

"I had a hip replacement last year," said MacLean, noting that
